What did you learn?

- Ongoing management of Patient (GPST2)
- Learned about EISS service (GP)
- Assessment of lymphadenopathy, assessment of PICA, Investigation of long term abdominal pain (GP)
- Lots of valuable info (HV)
- Learned how well MDT communicate and work together (student HV)
- When to be concerned regarding increased centile growth and tics. Knowing when blood tests are appropriate (GP)
- Knowledge on different health issues impacting infants/young children (HV)
- Investigations of potential growth issues, investigation of pains. Overlapping toes and foot abnormalities in neonates (GP)
- Work up of HSP (GPST2)
- Use of CK as an investigation (GP)
- Sport physio input for athletes (GP)
- Follow-up plotting of growth centiles. Atypical HSP (GPST2)
- Good MDT partnerships. Good to see the complications GPs have (APNP)
- Investigation of polyuria; further investigations of diarrhoea (GP)
- First Session but very informative – insight into common cases (HV)
- Focusing on development and using “watchful wait” appropriately (GP)
- Signs and symptoms of bronchiectasis and appropriate investigations, treatment for PBB; indication for MRI spine in back pain (GPST3)
